It has been quite a start to the 2022 academic year with lots of activity across all schools in our region. You will find here an update on what's been going on and some tasters of what is to come.

As a reminder for those of you who have not yet worked with us as a Hub our main remit is to support the CPD of teachers in all 161 schools in the Cheltenham, Stroud and Cotswold region of Gloucestershire. We are working closely in collaboration with Odyssey Teaching school Hub who serve the rest of the county. We intend to work closely with each and every school and aim to enhance the links between Curriculum Hubs and all educational providers across the region. Our main functions are...

- To deliver the Full Induction program for the Early Career Framework and the National **Professional Qualifications** (NPQs) in conjunction with Odyssey TS Hub.
- To offer Appropriate Body services for Early Career Teachers.

- To offer high-quality, evidence based professional development to school leaders and teachers. (CPD and training).
- To support Initial Teacher Training (ITT). We offer School Direct as Balcarras School and work with all providers in the county to ensure that trainee teachers have the best possible provision.

So far, since our launch in September 2021 we have worked with a total of 121 schools, and provided CPD or training to 700 teachers across all our programs. I want to pay a personal tribute to all support staff, facilitators and leaders involved in enabling us to reach so many teacher. We are excited to see that grow over the next academic year.

A SNAPSHOT OF 2021/22


